## LOVELY LIPS

If you aren't used to wearing strong colors on your mouth, try a sheer wash of red or bright pink like Tarte Natural Gel Lip Stain in Lust or Amused (\$24 each, above). "You can build it as you feel more comfortable," notes makeup artist Tina Turnbow. Paint the stain on your lips with your fingertip, says Turnbow, keeping the focus in the center of the mouth to further enhance your pout.

## LUSCIOUS LACQUER

"Candy-colored nails are it for spring," says Roxanne Valinoti, a CND educator. "It's a simple way to add a pop of color if you don't want it on your face." Nails should be no longer than your fingertips and look best with a high-shine top coat like Sally Hansen NailShine Miracle (\$7.95). "And keep your toes coordinated, not matching, by staying in the same color family."

## SECRETS TO WEARING COLOR

## GLOWING CHEEKS

"Less is more, so use a creamy texture for a sheer effect," says makeup artist Pat McGrath, who applied CoverGirl and Olay Simply Ageless Sculpting Blush in Royal Plum (\$10.99) at Versace. If you prefer powder, she recommends sweeping it lightly onto the apples and blending outward. Try Smashbox Fusion Soft Lights in Baked Starlight (\$30, right).

## ELECTRIC EYES

"Using a color like blue is a great way to brighten your eyes," explains makeup artist François Nars. He suggests smudging Nars Glitter Pencil in Bains Douches (\$24, right, used at Derek Lam) in and around your lash line. "It works with all skin tones." We also like Dolce & Gabbana Smooth Eye Colour Duo in Sky (\$36, above). "For a modern look, pair it with black mascara, clean skin, and a bright lip," instructs Nars.
